

Roadmap for the RPC Dialogue & Discernment Process Re Same-Sex Covenant Relationships/Marriage

We spent about 16 months addressing the question below as a community of Jesus-followers. We celebrate the respectful and loving conversations we had in many contexts – personal interactions, Grow Class discussions, Small

Group meetings, Congregational Meetings. Below is a summary of our process.

Focus Question:

How can the response of Reba Place Church to the presence of same-sex attraction in ourselves and others best reflect God's Good News as proclaimed by Jesus?

Goals:

- 1. To understand the issues and evidence that relate to our focus question from Scripture, our Christian tradition, our own and other's personal experiences, and reason/current science
- To discern and dialogue together in a manner that reflects the Great Commandments of loving God and loving people, and that exemplifies RPC's core values of being Real (authenticity), practicing Peacemaking that transforms both our hearts and the world, and **building Community**
- 3. To discern together by prayer and study and listening to God and one another, an answer to our focus question

Process and Timeline:

September-November 2017

- Overview

December 2017

We took a break for Advent

January 2018

Thinking about how we interpret the Bible with sermons by Joseph Marshak, John Cook, and David Janzen.

Lent 2018

Considering specific **Biblical texts** featuring the scholarship of Loren Johns, Wesley Hill, and Matthew Vines. Personal story from Dave Jackson.

Congregational **Circle Discussion** about the Bible and our thoughts so far

April 2018

Pause to think about how we think and how culture influences our moral decisionmaking. Book study Grow Class on The Righteous Mind with sermons reflecting on some of the same themes from the Bible.

April 29, 2018 **Panel Presentation**

about the experience of 4 LGBTQ Christians with the church

May-June 2018 **Small Group reflection** to give input to Dialogue Leadership Team

June 2018

Congregational **Service of Lament** & Prayer... for the pain inflicted on LGBTQ folks by Christians/the church, and prayer for the season of decision-making

June-July 2018

Congregational survey and feedback solicited from Small Groups

August - September 2018 A 3-person writing team, in consultation with RPC Leadership, drafted a proposal. At a **Congregational Meeting**, a few edits were made and then moved to voting. The modified proposal was affirmed by 96+% of members who voted.

October to end 2018

We reported our decision to denominational leaders We held an Aftercare Mtg and celebration.

Decision Rule: A 75% affirmative vote by RPC members is required by our bylaws to adopt any proposal which includes changes to doctrine or affiliation or anything considered of major importance.
